OSMANIA MEDICAL COLLEGE



OSMANIA MEDICAL COLLEGE

Osmania Medical College is a premier medical college in Hyderabad, India and is often ranked among the best medical colleges in the Nation. It was founded in 1846 as the Hyderabad Medical School, making it one of the oldest medical schools in the world. It is now under the gamut of Kaloji University of Health Sciences. The college was originally affiliated to the Osmania University of Hyderabad. It is the one of the old medical college in India.

OSMANIA GENERAL HOSPITAL

Osmania General Hospital (OGH) is one of the oldest hospitals in India located at Afzal Gunj. Hyderabad. It is run by the Government of Telangana and is one of the largest in the state. The hospital building is a heritage structure. The hospital was completed in 1919 and was designed by British architect Vincent-Jerome Esch and Nawab Khan Bahadur Mirza Akbar Baig. He also designed The High Court, City High School, Railway Station of Hyderabad for His Exalted Highness (H.E.H) Osman Ali Khan, the Nizam of Hyderabad in Indo-Sarcenic style.

OSMANIA MEDICAL COLLEGE



HISTORY

1846:	Opening of the Nizam's Medical School by Dr. William Maclean for the teaching European Medicine in Urdu language to the native youth of Deccan. The school was located in a rented building at Gun foundry and later clinical instruction was given in the Residency Dispensary (now called Sultan Bazar Hospital).
1866:	Construction and opening of the Afzalgunj Hospital for clinical teaching to the medical students.
1908:	The Great flood in Moosi destroys part of the Afzalgunj building. Hospital was rebuilt.
1912:	Suggestions to build a new hospital on the best models of the West.
1918-20:	Planning and construction of the new hospital.
1920:	Medical school converted into medical college.
1922:	The classes and other teaching departments shifted from Sultan Bazar to a private building near Khairatabad.
1925-26:	The new Osmania General Hospital was completed and the hospital shifted from Afzal Gunj buildings into the new premises.
1952:	Government of Hyderabad takes over the administrative control of the medical college from the University. A Government medical officer was appointed as head of the college and the hospital.
1955:	Inauguration of the Postgraduate courses in Medicine.
1956:	Laying of the foundation stone for the new building in Residency Compound by Dr. B. Ramakrishna Rao, Chief Minister of Hyderabad State.
1962:	Opening of the present campus at Koti, Hyderabad.

GANDHI MEDICAL COLLEGE



On September 14th 1954 our college was established in the erstwhile State of Hyderabad. It began as a private institute under the management of Anwar UI - Uloom Educational Society of Indian Medical association. It was the first Medical College after Hyderabad joined the Indian Union. The college could not be sustained on account of financial difficulties. Chief Minister Dr. Burgula Ramakrishna Rao intervened and took it over to run it as a government college. On June 25th 1955 the name was changed to Gandhi Medical College and inaugurated by the President of India Dr. Rajendra Prasad. After the reorganization of the Indian states and formation of Andhra Pradesh the college was moved to buildings in Basheerbagh that were built in 1890. In 1958 Chief Minister Dr. Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy inaugurated the college on Basheerbagh Road.

History of Our College from 2000 to 2004: Story of Relocation to current premises in Musheerabad.

The first foundation stone for construction of GMC/GH campus was laid by Dr. N.T. Rama Rao on January 5th 1987. The Chief Minister Shri. Chandrababu Naidu laid the foundation stone for the second time. It took over two years to complete the construction and the college relocated to Musheerabad on 21-11-2003 and the hospital in 2004.

History of Gandhi Hospital

Gandhi Hospital began as an infirmary near Secunderabad Railway Station. It was established by the British Government in 1851.By early twentieth century the facility had expanded and had 95 beds with three wards. The hospital was further expanded with charitable contributions by philanthropists and given the name King Edwards Memorial Hospital in memory of King Edward VII (KEM HOSPITAL). It was opened by the British Resident ,Mr. S.M .Fraser on 20th December 1917. Until 1958 the students of People's Medical College and the GMC had to round at Osmania General Hospital for clinical experience. KEM was renamed Gandhi Hospital and thus the teaching hospital for GMC.. In 2004 it moved to the current location. primarily serves the poor people of the city.

Gandhi, Osmania Medical Colleges put up impressive show

The medical education in the State-run teaching hospitals of Telangana has started to get its due recognition with Gandhi Medical College (GMC) getting 16th rank in the Indian Today Magazine Ranking list of top 40 best medical colleges in India for year 2019.

Last year, the rankings had the GMC at 20th position and this year, it improved by four places. The Osmania Medical College (OMC) also finds a place in the list with 21st rank.

FUTURE PLANS

KAKATIYA MEDICAL COLLEGE



Kakatiya Medical College was founded in 1959 by the Warangal Regional Medical Education Society (RMES) with the active support of the then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Neelam Sanjiva Reddy. The Director of Medical Services of A.P. and the Warangal District Collector Mohsin Bin Shabbir (whose picture adorns the main entrance of the medical school with quote 'The Earth sometimes bears gems and here is one') to provide medical education for students of the Telangana region of the State.

The college was inaugurated on 23rd July 1959 by the P. Karmarkar. Minister of Health, Government of India. It was originally in a building donated by the Pingili family at Waddepally and it moved into the makeshift building constructed at the permanent site in November 1961.

152.17 acres of land was acquired for the medical college in Warangal and the permanent building of the college was constructed at an estimated cost of about Rs. 47 lakhs. Indira Gandhi, the then Prime Minister of India inaugurated the permanent campus in 1966.

The temporary sheds which were constructed earlier had been remodeled to the boys' hostel. A permanent building for the girls' hostel was constructed and inaugurated by Sri J. Chokka Rao, Chairman A.P Regional Committee in 1970. An impressive auditorium with an open-air stage was constructed behind the college with cinematographic equipment which can accommodate 500 students.

The A.P Government took over the college from RMES in February 1977. In the same year the college affiliation was transferred to Kakatiya University from Osmania University. And since 1st March 1987 the college was affiliated with University of Health Sciences, now Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal. The postgraduate courses were started in 1972 and the college is conducting postgraduate courses in all departments.

GANDHI MEDICAL COLLEGE GLOBAL ALLIANCE (GMCGA)



Mission: GMCGA was incorporated as a non-profit organization in 2005 to foster kinship among the alumni with a mission to enhance educational programs and patient care services centered at the alma mater.

Vision: To achieve and maintain the reputation as a reliable and respected philanthropic organization in medical education and healthcare.

Alumni Education Center (AEC): The first major accomplishment of GMCGA was the construction of the AEC in 2006 in collaboration with Gandhi Medical College Alumni Association (GMCAA) under the auspices of Alumni Educational Society (AES). The AEC is a three-level structure with around 15,000 sq ft. of space containing two auditoriums and classrooms for professional meetings, CME programs and academic functions. The AEC has a heritage lounge with the legendary staircase that was originally a centerpiece at the old Gandhi Hospital. The AEC has been the center for all educational activities where CME activities with international faculty are conducted and in 2016, the American Heart Association (AHA) recognized the AEC as an International Training Center (ITC) to conduct AHA approved ACLS & ELS courses





International Training Center (ITC)/American Heart Association (AHA) Certified ACLS/BLS/PALS Training Program: After the construction of AEC and getting official recognition from AHA in 2016; Dr. Surakanti established the ITC, which was the first of its kind in

Telangana & Andhra States. Since that time, the program has gone from strength to strength offering AHA Certified provider and instructor courses in BLS. ACLS & PALS and also Community CPR programs. Several thousand people including medical & nursing students & professionals, House surgeons, PGs, allied healthcare 30 law enforcement professionals, students and members of the general public have been trained in the various training programs offered by



Student Financial Grant (SFG) Programs GMCGA in cellaboration with GMCAA and EKAM foundation established the SFG program in 2021. This program provides support in the form of a grant to undergraduate students of GMC who are in need of financial support to complete their medical education. A total of sixty students (fifteen from each year) are given Rs 3500 per month till they complete their final year of MBBS.

Pain Clinic & Pain Management Programs GMCGA in collaboration with the Anesthesia Department of GMC/GH established a pain clinic at Gandhi Hospital in 2018- the first of its kind in the history of Gandhi Hospital. In addition to this, a Pain Management Education/Training Program was established in collaboration with Center for Pain Management, USA and several education/training conferences & CME events including virtual classes for undergraduate, postgraduate students and staff of GMC/GH are being conducted.



Road to Residency Mentorship Program: This program established in 2022 offers guidance to GMC students and alumni who are interested in pursuing further education, training and career opportunities in USA.



Virtual Classes, Teaching, Training & CME Programs: GMCGA established the first of their kind virtual teaching/training programs for the staff. undergraduate and postgraduate students at GMC/GH in 2022 in addition to several in person CME programs and events. Virtual classes are being conducted in several departments including Gastroenterology, Nephrology, Endocrinology and Pain Management.

Equipment Donation Program: Since its inception, GMCGA has donated and will continue to donate medical equipment and supplies to several departments/specialties in GMC/GH.

COVID-19 Assistance Program: Since Gandhi Hospital was a designated center for COVID during the pandemic, GMCGA raised funds and donated money and lifesaving equipment to Gandhi Hospital and other regional hospitals like ENT hospital.

Community Outreach Programs:

GPR Training Program: This community outreach program is one of the most popular projects of GMCGA. This program teaches basic CPR skills to the general public including school scudents, public officials and also medical, paramedical and healthcare professionals. This program, through its widespread reach is providing the basic skills of resuscitation to the general public which in turn, is saving lives. Impressed by the utility and popularity of this program, the Governor of Telangana Smt. Tamilisai Soundararajan attended one of the sessions and also had one session conducted at Rajbhavan



Non Communicable Diseases (NCD) Program: This community ourreach program brings awareness and educates the medical fraternity, school teachers and parents about lifestyle related preventable NCDs, thereby decreasing their incidence and prevalence.
